## QUICK FACTS ABOUT THE #MMIR CRISIS

Four out of five Native American women will experience violence within their lifetime.

Out of those four out of five, more than half will experience sexual violence.

Native American and Alaska Native rates of murder, rape, and violent crime are all higher than the national averages.

Children are highly targeted via social media and online gaming by human and sex traffickers. Sex traffickers can be other relatives, friends, or complete strangers.

Native men are more likely to be subjected to intimate partner violence and psychological abuse from counterparts, which often leads men to remain silent.

75-85% of Two-Spirits (LBTQIA+ community) are harassed and assaulted (physically and/or sexually) for not fitting into the hetero-norm of society which often leads them to be unseen and unheard in the event they go missing (and murdered).
